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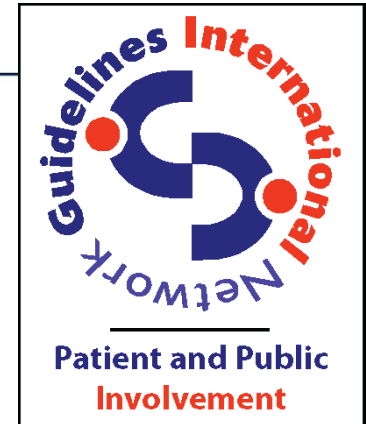

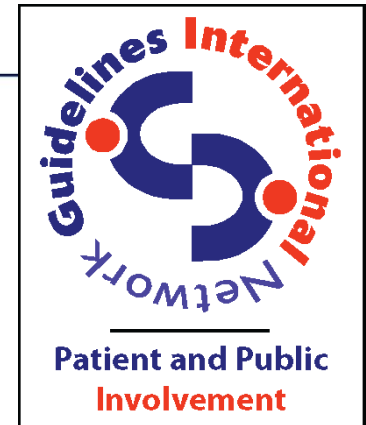

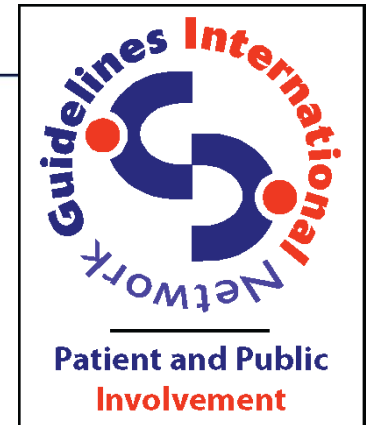

- Elaborate a common research agenda at the international level, including development of standard measures of evaluation.

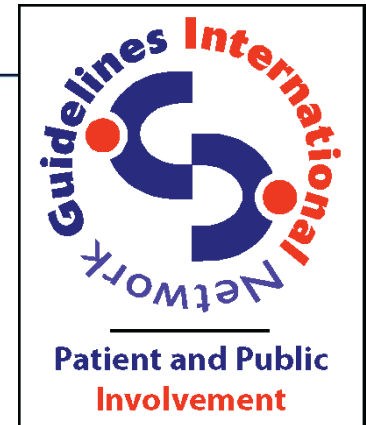
