

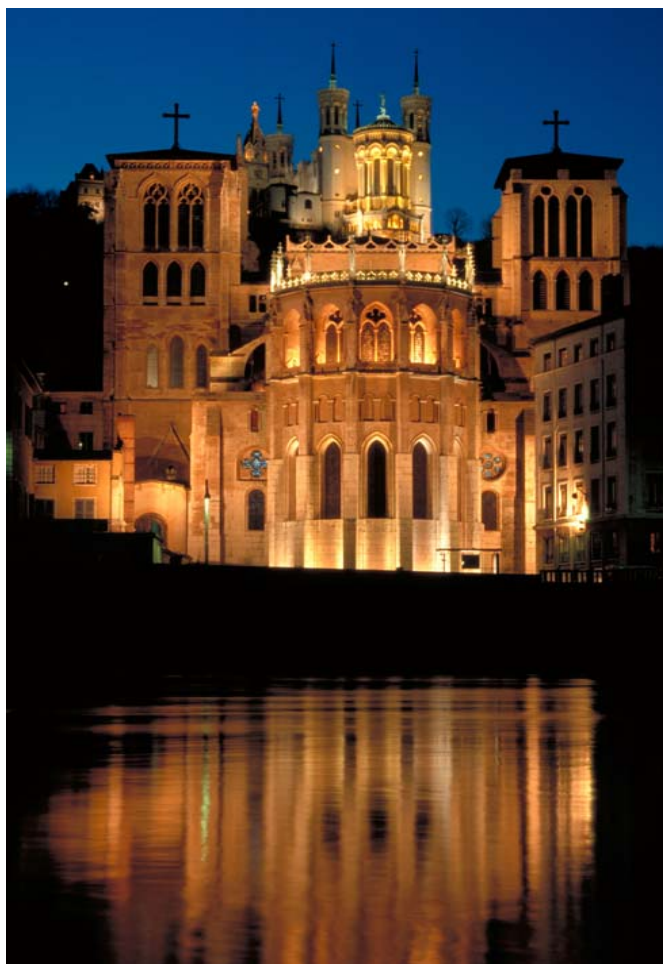

The Third Guidelines International Conference will be organized by the French National Federation of Comprehensive Cancer Centres (FNCLCC), under the patronage of the Supreme Health Authority (Haute Autorité de Santé). The theme of the Conference is **Evidence in Context**. The conference will be near Lyon, France in the setting of annual symposia organized by 'Le Centre Jacques Cartier'. These symposia are organised annually, alternatively in the Rhone-Alpes region in France and in the province of Quebec in Canada. The programme will run from 9.00 am on Monday 5 December 2005 to 1.00 pm on Wednesday 7 December 2005.

The programme will include plenary session and parallel oral sessions as well as workshops on:

- **Integration of cultural and contextual considerations in guidelines** –how to integrate these considerations in guidelines and their impact on the recommendations, what words to use to write guidelines
- **Developing guidelines** – Living guidelines, updating processes and adaptation of existing guidelines
- **Methodology of guideline development** – best practices, reduced development time, shared development, grading the evidence, including economic evaluation data
- **Patients and guidelines**, how to involve patients in the guideline development process, patient versions of guidelines, patient empowerment and consumer involvement
- **Guidelines in use** – how uptake of guidelines can be encouraged, use of guidelines by healthcare deciders, and payers, electronic decision systems
