Richard Mendelson was a consultant gastrointestinal radiologist at Royal Perth Hospital from 1986 until retirement from clinical practice in 2015. He is now an Emeritus Consultant at that hospital. He is a Clinical Professor at the University of Western Australia and at the Notre Dame University. He has authored or co-authored 8 books or book chapters and over 60 papers and editorials.

He was founding chairman of the Abdominal Radiology Group of Australia and New Zealand (ARGANZ) until 2014, and is an Honorary Fellow of the European Society of Gastrointestinal and Abdominal Radiology. He was awarded the Roentgen Medal by the Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Radiologists in 2013 and Life Membership in 2014.

Richard has a career-long interest in the appropriate use of diagnostic imaging being founding Editor of 'Diagnostic Imaging Pathways' (an on-line clinical decision support and educational tool for referrers to diagnostic imaging: www.imagingpathways.health.wa.gov.au) that has achieved national and international acclaim.
