As of February 2024, INGUIDE has achieved a significant impact, with a total of 1,900 learners enrolled, out of which 1,165 have achieved certification. This is primarily achieved through its core curriculum training guideline panel members, methodologists, panel chairs, and INGUIDE instructors. To ensure the delivery of contextualized learning experiences, the program is currently undergoing translations of its foundational course "Certified Guideline Panel Member" into more than 10 languages. Additionally, new courses and add-on modules are in the design phase, tailored to meet the evolving needs of the market.
